RULES OF PLAY

THE COURSE

Glenross's 6,500-yard, par-70 golf course features four sets of tees on each hole. The all new bentgrass tees, fairways and greens will further compliment each hole. Renovation occurred from tee through green on each of the existing 13 holes and five holes have completely new layout and design. Our beautiful course boasts rolling fairways, undulating greens, fifty new sand bunkers, seven ponds and a natural creek. Acres of wetlands, natural grass areas and hundreds of trees have been added to further challenge golfers and enhance the overall playing experience.

FORMAT

- The format for today is a scramble
- Men will be playing from **blue tees** women from the **red tees** and 60 year or older individuals from the **white tees**.
- Pick the best tee shot and mark the spot. Other team members' balls can be placed within one club length so long as it remains in the same cut of grass or within a hazard. Lies can be improved with your club head.
- Par is Your Partner – there will be a limit of par on each hole. To speed up play, once your team has reached the maximum score, please pick up your ball and move onto the next hole.
- There is a time limit of 3 minutes to look for a lost golf ball.
- In the bag you received at registration, you will find 2 drink tickets to be used with the beverage cart. After you have used your tickets, additional drinks may be purchased from the beverage cart or clubhouse. The beverage cart drivers are employees of the golf course (tips are encouraged).
- Please turn in your score card to the golf course officials immediately following your round.
- Tie breakers to be determined by the golf course official.
- Presentations will be made at the reception following the completion of play.

SKILL CONTESTS

- Hole #3 – First person to score a Hole-in-One wins \$10,000.

TIPS FOR LINEMEN TO KEEP YOURSELF Safe.

Numbers from the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics put electrical lineworkers among the top ten most dangerous jobs in the United States. Safety is our number one priority, and safety measures have greatly increased over time. Follow these tips to stay safe on the job.



- **Work in teams.** Always remember to communicate with your crew and look out for each other's safety! It's important to remember you are a team, so make sure every team member is safe.
- **Slow down:** Most mistakes occur when workers are rushed to finish a job. Taking your time helps ensure that the job is done right and carefully.
- **Wear proper safety equipment.** Of all safety tips, this one is most important. In the event of an incident, your equipment, helmet, gloves, shoes, and clothing will provide an extra layer of protection.
- **Be aware of your surroundings.** When working on the line, the smallest movement can lead to an accident. Remain calm, move mindfully, and be aware of the supplies around you.
- **Use tools properly.** Don't use tools you are not trained with and always practice proper tool safety. Stay up to date with safety trainings and best practices.
- **Be prepared for the weather.** Whether its 100 degrees or -30 degrees, always be prepared. In the summer months, remember to stay hydrated!
- **Get your equipment tested.** This is crucial for staying safe on the job. A damaged ground or a glove with a hole could be extremely dangerous.
- **Remember.** Look out for your crew members and speak up when you see a hazard. It's always better to be safe than sorry. For more information on lineworker safety, review OSHA's Electric Power Generation, Transmission, and Distribution Industry safety guidelines.
